Acceptable items With Fees

AG PLASTICS (\$49.00 per ton effective January 1, 2016) Tires* @10¢ per pound, Appliances, TV's, computers, electronics @ \$10.00 per item, fluorescent tubes @ 50 cents each* \$3 per HID lamp *Tires and bulbs are rounded to the nearest dollar

We will not accept the following: Explosives (shotguns shells, fireworks, gunpowder, etc.) Radioactive materials Garbage and large items (couches, chairs, demolition material)

Monroe County reserves the right to charge a fee for quantities of hazardous waste over 5 gallons or 50 lbs. Prices may be subject to change.
